tively involved in several humanitarian causes such as the Medical Missions for Children (MMFC). As the West Coast director of operations, Dr. Azizzadeh travels with MMFC to third-world countries to treat children with cleft lip and palate disorders as well as burn injuries. In the upcoming year, he will spend several weeks traveling to rural Peru and Ecuador to dedicate his time for these disadvantaged children. He is also actively involved in fund-raising efforts for MMFC and will be hosting a wine tasting gala in the spring of 2004.

Azizzadeh is also devoted to the Reconstructive Surgery Program of the R.O.S.E. Fund (Regaining One's Self-esteem). He provides free surgery for women surviving domestic violence. Strongly committed to the cause, Azizzadeh is establishing a base operation here in California.

In his Beverly Hills practice, Azizzadeh specializes exclusively in aesthetic and reconstructive plastic surgery of the face, neck, eyes, and nose. He utilizes microsurgical techniques to reconstruct complex head and neck cancer/trauma defects at Cedars-Sinai Medical Center and UCLA Harbor Medical Center. These operations transfer bone and tissue from various regions of the body to restore facial function and aesthetics. Azizzadeh also has extensive expertise in facial nerve paralysis reconstruction. This combination of training in both cosmetic and reconstructive surgery places Azizzadeh at the forefront of Facial Plastic Surgery.
